

ITU-T Ad-Hoc Coordination Status

- ITU-T Coordination Ad-Hoc Meeting planned for May 29-30 cancelled
- Clarification within PCG that 3GPP cannot take direct positions with ITU-T (Ability to reply to liaisons is under debate)
- Reorganization of ITU-T IMT-2000 work underway in ITU-T. Relationship between ITU-T and 3GPP being discussed.
- Possible GSC-6 Ad-Hoc to be called to discuss relationship between ITU-T and 3GPPx (Nov/Dec, 2000).
- ITU-T Coordination Ad-Hoc convenor (Masami Yabusaki, DoCoMo) has resigned.



ITU-T Coordination Proposal from TSG-CN

- Allow 3GPP be represented in GSC-6 Ad-Hoc
 - Preference is to have a 3GPP delegation
 - Fallback is to have coordinated 3GPP position and 3GPP delegates on each OP delegations
 - Request that GSC-6 Ad Hoc be delayed until Jan. 2001
 - Allow 3GPP time to consider new structure agreed at WTSA
 - Agreement on 3GPP position at CN#10
- ITU-T Coordination Ad-Hoc meets to discuss positions prior to GSC-6 Ad-Hoc
 - Charter expanded at CN#9 to allow formulation of non-technical positions
 - Meeting to formulate position between CN#9 and CN#10
- Position of 3GPP towards GSC-6 Ad-Hoc agreed at CN#10.
