Dear Colleagues,

The 3GPP/TISPAN Workshop on NGN was very productive. The meeting agreed to a set of principles on how the two organizations would work together (TD17r1_3GPP_TISPAN_NGN) and a set of initial issues and the way forward on each of these issues (TD16r1_WS_highlights_NGN-issues-handling). These two documents are attached to this e-mail. The official report will come out sometime later.

Here are some additional clarifications and context for these two documents.

1. The TISPAN/3GPP collaboration principles (TD17r1_3GPP_TISPAN_NGN) are based upon the 3GPP/IETF collaboration principles. NGN work on IMS needed by TISPAN will be pushed within 3GPP by 3GPP member companies.
2. For additional IETF work needed for IMS (to meet NGN requirements) all IETF requirements should be channeled through the appropriate CN WG.
3. TISPAN is assuming 3GPP Rel 6 as the basis for their work in determining any extensions necessary. Most of the IMS changes required are expected to be included as part of 3GPP Rel 7 although there might be minor things that could be done in Rel 6.
