**Title:** Proposal for possible liaison procedure with ITU-T

The guidelines for the activity of the ITU Ad Hoc approved by TSG RAN during the second Plenary meeting (Fort Lauderdale, 2-4 March 1999) state that 'The task of ITU Ad Hoc is to act as a focus to ensure a proper flow of information and contributions between 3GPP and ITU-R TG 8/1'.

Recognizing that some topic under consideration by TSG RAN may be relevant for ITU-T, there was a discussion on whether or not it is appropriate to consider the possibility to submit documents developed in ITU Ad Hoc to ITU-T (via Individual Memebrship).

With reference to ETSI, it was commented that also SPS is responsible for liaison with ITU-T; therefore, it would be appropriate to inform SPS of any contribution developed in ITU Ad Hoc for submission to ITU-T.

It is therefore proposed to add to the guidelines for the activity of ITU Ad Hoc the following sentence:

'If necessary, contributions developed in ITU Ad Hoc can be submitted to ITU-T using the same procedure adopted for the submission to ITU-R TG 8/1. In addition, these contributions have to be sent for information to ETSI SPS as well.'
