<b>Reason for change:</b> ⌘	In RAN3 #28 it was mentioned that there is a need to clarify TR 25.878 in order to cope with an update occurred in TS 25.133, which appears to be quoted in the technical report. Although the assumption made by referencing an out-of-date part of 25.133 has no impact and no consequence on the solution RAN3 adopted regarding to the WI 'RL Timing Adjustment' it was agreed to replace such text with a reference to the latest version of 25.133.
<b>Summary of change:</b> ⌘	The current text referring to 25.133 was removed and a reference to 25.133 was added. R1: update to the cover sheet's reason for change to indicate that the reference is not to 5.1.0 but to the latest version of 25.133(the affected sentence is highlighted).
<b>Consequences if not approved:</b> ⌘	An outdated reference would persist in 25.878. The present change does not influence the RL Timing adjustment mechanism specified in RAN3/RAN2 TSs.
