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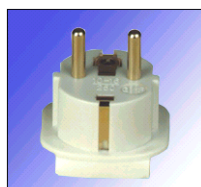

The currency is Swedish krona. The exchange rate is ~10 SEK for 1 € and ~7 SEK for 1 US\$. Most foreign currencies are easily changed at banks or hotels.

Central European Time (CET)

### **Voltage:**

Commercial power in Stockholm is **230V**. Please be sure you have the correct adapter. Voltage converters will **not** be provided at the meeting.
