Title: Proposed modification to CR cover sheet

Background

In recent meetings of CN2, CN4 and the SA1 CAMEL ad hoc, there has been confusion over the category F on the CR cover sheet, particularly when corrections to a frozen release were being discussed. TR 21.900 table 4A defines category F as a **correction**; the text of TR 21.900 subclause 4.6.2 indicates that for a correction to a frozen release, this category needs further refinement. **One** of the subordinate classifications of category F is "essential correction".

However the current version of the CR cover sheet indicates that category F is an **Essential correction**, which can lead to the peculiar situation that a correction to a frozen release which **is not** seen as an essential correction but **is** accepted by consensus in the meeting has to have an indication on the CR cover sheet that this is an essential correction which is not an essential correction!

Proposal

To correct this anomaly, it is proposed that the word "Essential" is deleted from the definition of category F on the CR cover sheet; this will align the CR cover sheet definition with TR 21.900
