Release 97, 98, 99 Status

- Cleanup of Equivalent PLMN List and Reject Cause Code Handling
- Several contentious issues resolved
 - Compromise Solution worked out for Multicall Handover
 - Handling of CAMEL 2 & 3 for Non-Supported AoC
 - SMS Reference Number optional for CAMEL 3
- Shared Interworking Function now removed
- High volume of CAMEL 3 corrections



Release 4 Status

- Still waiting on correction of references to withdraw 04.08
- High number of corrections to BICSCN





Release 5 Status

- Non-IMS Work Items in good shape for Mar. 02
 - AMR-WB
 - Need coordination with SA3 LI (Legal Intercept)
 - Service Change and UDI Fallback
 - Connection of RAN nodes to multiple CN nodes (luFlex)
 - CAMEL 4 (non-IMS part)
- IMS Work Items at high risk for slippage past Mar. 02



- IMS Call Control
 - CN1 responsibility
 - More than 100 open items in 3GPP specs
 - Critical IETF specs probably not ready in time
 - CN decision: No workarounds yet (re-assess in March)
 - Very high risk: Not ready by March 02
- Sh I/f (SIP Application Server <-> HSS)
 - No work done in CN4
 - No WID
 - Impossible to be ready by March 02



- IMS Support in CAMEL 4
 - CN2 responsibility
 - New spec 23.278
 - Work on Si (IM-SSF<->HSS) not started
 - Stage 2 responsibility of CN2
 - Stage 3 responsibility of CN4
 - Impossible to be ready by March 02
- IMS-CS Interworking
 - CN3 responsibility
 - Scope expanded to include BICC interworking
 - ITU-T specs probably not ready in time



- IMS-PS Interworking
 - CN3 responsibility
 - Focus shifted to native SIP to 3GPP SIP interworking (from H.323 interworking)
 - Draft spec (29.162) not yet presented for information
 - Does not address IPv4/IPv6 interworking
 - Very high risk: Not ready by March 02
- Go (QoS Policy Control)
 - CN3 responsibility
 - Dependency on IETF multimedia application
 - Draft specs (29.207, 29.208) not yet presented for info
 - Very high risk: Not ready by March 02



- Cx (CSCF-HSS I/f)
 - CN4 responsibility
 - Dependency on IETF multimedia application
 - 3GPP specs probably ready in time
 - Very high risk: Not ready by March 02
- OSA Enhancements for multimedia
 - CN5 responsibility
 - Currently focusing on OSA <-> "Basic SIP" mapping
 - Delta planned for OSA <-> ISC mapping
 - Included in 29.998-4 (Call Control Mapping)
 - Also includes XML support

- SA3 Request for Ze (MAP Key mgmt) I/f protocol
 - Falls in CN4 responsibility
 - Needs joint meetings with SA3
 - Not ready by March 02
 - Liaison sent from CN to SA3 (SP-010730)
- IMS Framework Support
 - CN1 not currently able to provide verification input due to high load
 - Informal meeting held after CN plenary to discuss feedback needed
 - CN ultimately responsible for protocol enablers



- CN participation in UE split discussions
 - Primary CN involvement from CN1
 - Seems primarily to be an SA1/SA2/SA3/T3 discussion
 - CN1 can provide protocol evaluation after requirements/architecture discussions evolve
- CN participation in ISIM discussions
 - Primary CN involvement from CN1
 - Seems primarily to be an SA1/SA2/SA3/T3 discussion
 - CN1 can provide expertise only if meeting collocated with CN1 meetings



- Reduction of CAMEL 4 Scope
 - Deletion proposed due to lack of progress
 - Charging Notification
 - Enhanced Dialled Services
 - SA1 asked to confirm deletion (SP-010731)
- New CN WIDs approved:
 - Rel 5: Connection of RAN nodes to multiple CN nodes (luFlex)
 - Rel 6?: Presence



- 3GPP/3GPP2 CN Harmonization
 - Scope not clarified by OHG workshop request
 - Workshop only useful if it has well defined scope
 - One alternative is to focus on a harmonization roadmap
- Winter Cleaning (option reduction)
 - No activity in CN
 - Issue larger than just CN



- M3UA/SUA
 - M3UA Only in Rel 5
 - No Wis on alternate solutions planned
 - SUA Feasibility Study (TR 29.903) approved
