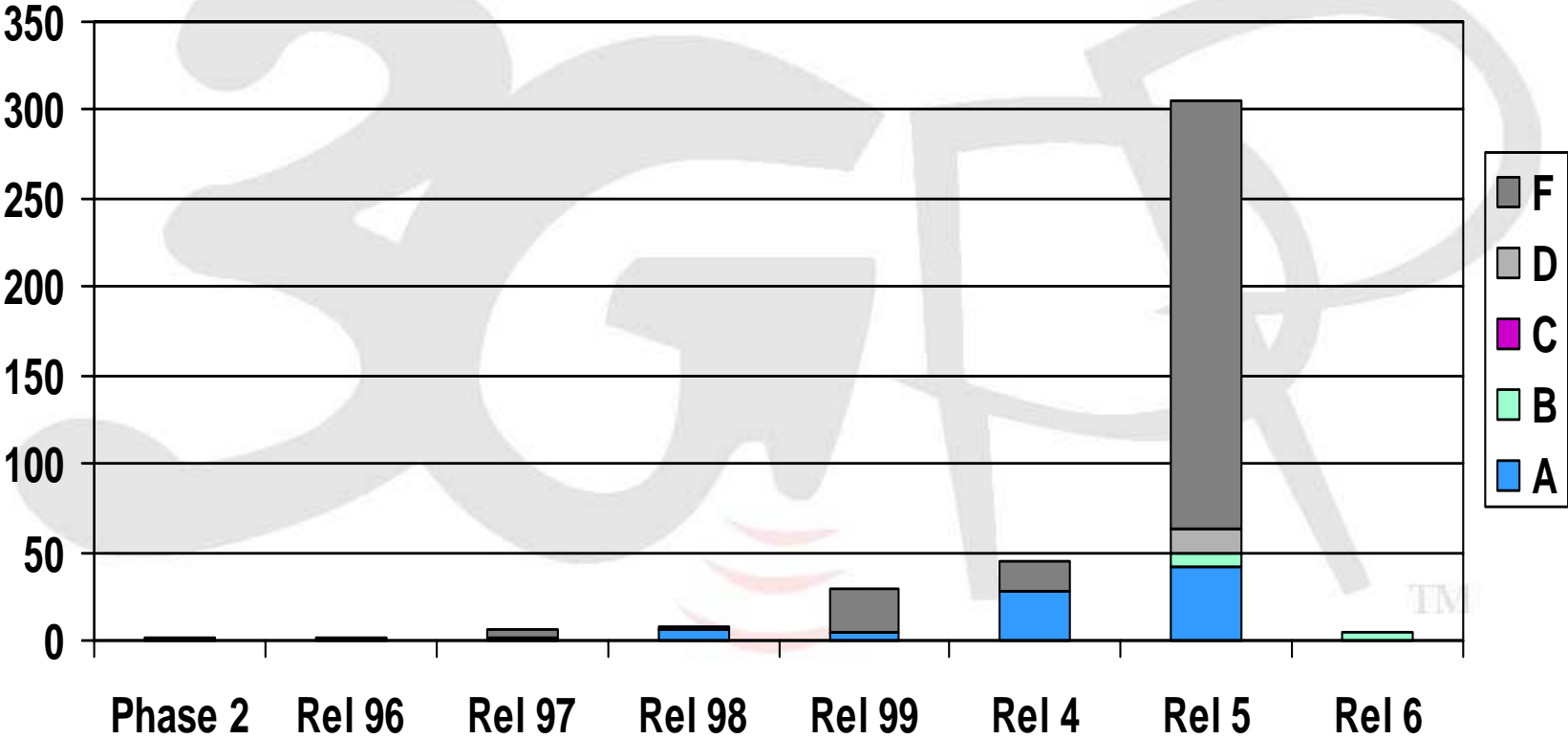

# Release 5 Status Overview (non-IMS)



- **Functional enhancements requested by other groups**
  - Optional Support of IP on Iu for CS (Requested by RAN)
  - CS Data Services for GERAN Iu Mode (Requested by GERAN)
- **SMS over GPRS**
  - Reject code 69 to be used in Release 5 for non-support of SMS over GPRS
  - No positive indicator of SMS support mechanisms currently planned (CN felt this was a new service requirement)
- **SS via GPRS (NP-020672 – LS to SA1)**
  - Acceptable to do SS barring invocation of SMS for Rel 6, but not as a backwards requirement for Rel 5.
  - Large amount of work required for SS control via GPRS. Is this worthwhile doing in any release?
- **Emergency number Download for Rel 6**
  - Download in both CS and PS domain

## Release 5 Status Overview (IMS)

- **IMS now stable**
  - Some cleanup in TS 24.228 still required
  - Most IETF specs expected to be approved by IESG (except for Diameter)
- **IETF Interworking (LS in SP-020800)**
  - P-CSCF non-stripping of headers (conditional)
  - CSCF non-editing of SDP headers (conditional)
  - S-CSCF obfuscation of To: and From: headers
  - CSCF manipulation of message bodies
  - Comp=sigcomp (late compatibility issue)
- **IETF interworking now considered complete**
- **Need for work on subscribed media (LS in SP-020799)**
  - Clarification on media options which can be controlled by subscriber

## Release 6 (New or Revised Items)

- **Mn interface**
  - MGCF to IM-MGW
  - Target is June 03
- **Mp interface**
  - MRFC to MRFP
  - Target is June 03
- **Presence**
  - Target slipped to June 03
- **Ze (MAP key distribution)**
  - Target is Sept 03
- **OSA Release 6**
  - Contents based upon SA1 TS 22.127

## Release 6 (New or Revised Items)

- **Interoperability and Commonality between IP Multimedia Systems using different "IP-connectivity Networks"; stage 3**
  - IETF references updated
- **Interworking between IMS and IP**
  - TR 29.962 on interworking of SIP and non-SIP profile
  - Completion of TR in CN#20
- **Interworking between IMS and CS**
  - ITU-T slippage of Q.1912.SIP until at least November 03
  - CN3 will produce standalone document with resync to ITU in April 03
  - Goal is long term alignment with ITU and referencing if possible
  - Slippage until June 03
- **Planned WIDs (agreement in principle)**
  - Enhanced dialled services (if agreed in SA)
  - WLAN

## Questions for Guidance from SA

- **Methodology for Network Integration Testing (LS in SP-020821)**
  - Request consolidated 3GPP view and response to ETSI TC MTS
- **IMS access using SIM**
  - CN WGs will await SA guidance
  - Very late requirement for Release 5
- **Enhanced dialled services**
  - Need go-ahead from SA to start on this work
  - CN2 WI will be created
- **Making Life Easier on CN and CN WGs**
  - Provide liaisons to CN in a timely manner
  - No more Release 5 category B or C CRs in SA1 or SA2
- **Planned workshop with IETF on Rel 6 requirements**
  - Need SA1 & SA2 requirements
