1. Overall Description:

S3 thanks ITU-T SG17 for the LS: Information of new ITU-T Recommendations for secure mobile end-to-end data communication, X.1121 and X.1122.

A discussion took place at meeting S3 #33. It was noted that they do not reference the 3GPP specifications, and it was thought that this might be useful, as there are many security features specified by S3 that are relevant.

In particular, Lawful Interception specifications have not been supported in the proposed recommendations. S3 notes that in many countries Lawful Interception is required by mandatory requirements, and standards must meet these requirements. Otherwise there is a risk that they will not be able to be used.
