T3 thank T2 for their reply to the liaison statement concerning the introduction of CPHS features. The following clarifications to the Voice Mail section have been provided as requested:

- T3 is not proposing to make any changes to the transfer of the voice mail indication or other message waiting indications across the network.
- 2. T3 confirms that the functionality described in the T2 liaison for storage of message waiting notification is correct, i.e. it shall include indication storage on the USIM for voicemail, faxmail, email indication and "other" indication, as available in 23.038 and 23.040. Furthermore, T3 have drafted CRs to 23.038 and 23.040 (see attached documents T3-010104 and T3-010105, respectively) to reflect these proposed changes to the USIM. T3 request that these CRs are reviewed at the next T2 plenary so that T3 can process the release of the related documents in time for Rel-4.
- 3. T3 confirms that the functionality described in the T2 liaison for mailbox numbers is also correct, i.e. the ME extracts the mailbox number from the USIM in order to call a mailbox number. It can be left to the network to transfer the appropriate message waiting indication to set or clear the message waiting notification as presently defined in 23.038 and 23.040.
