**1. Overall Description:**

SA 2 have briefly considered this issue and agree with the following SA1 statement in S2-032811 = S1-030922

“SA1 agreed that the principle requirement is to provide a higher bandwidth channel to USAT, than that currently provided by SMS.”

SA 2 understand that many Over The Air SIM updates use multiple (eg >20) SMSes and SA 2 note that the SMS architecture is not well optimised for this. Hence, MMS appears to be a suitable ‘bearer’ to use as a natural evolution of multiple concatenated SMSes.
