**1. Overall Description:**

SA2 thanks T2 for their LS on MMS WID MM4 Private addressing (TP-030310 received by SA2 as SP-030746). SA2 had 2 comments on this document

1. It was clarified that “VPN” usually stands for “Virtual Private Network” and NOT for “Virtual Private Numbering”. Hence it was suggested to use “Support of Private Numbering Plan” to name this feature
2. SA2 would like to know whether work on the WID would induce any change on existing CN specifications (e.g. on MAP when a MMS R/S tries to determine the address of a target MMS R/S). If that were the case SA2 as well as relevant CN groups (e.g. CN4) would then need be involved in the discussion.
