Candidate for 3GPP TSG SA Vice-Chairman

Christian received an Engineer Diploma in Computer Science in 1983 and has over 25 years experience in the Information Technology and Telecommunications industries.

He joined Cap Gemini in 1985 and worked 4 years on development and testing in the Software Engineering area. He has been involved in Wireless Operation and Maintenance from 1989 when he joined Matra Communication, which became part of Nortel Networks in 1992.

He worked as a team leader on the development of Nortel Networks' GSM OMC-R until 1992. He later became the leader of the OMC-R Architecture team and took charge of the specifications of the Q3 interface in that capacity.

In 1997, he joined the Nortel Networks system team and contributed to the GSM Radio Access Network functional requirements and specifications. In this position, he was later involved in the UMTS studies until 2000.

From 2001, Christian was responsible for OAM Standards and Partnerships within the Nortel Networks Wireless Internet Solutions organization, and was in charge of the development of several projects in cooperation with Nortel China R&D in Beijing.

Christian was located in Beijing in 2004 and 2005, and was focused on China Market specific requirements in addition to his responsibilities in Standards.

Christian started participation in 3GPP in September 2000 and has been attending all SA5 meetings from that time. He was elected Vice Chairman of SA5 in March 2003 and became Chairman of SA5 in August 2005, attending all TSG SA meetings from that time. He was confirmed Chairman of SA5 in May 2006 and was then re-elected in August 2007, August 2009, August 2011, and August 2013. He was elected Vice-Chairman of 3GPP TSG SA in March 2013.

Christian joined Huawei Technologies in March 2006. He is working in France with regular stays in China. He is leading the Huawei Standards team in Paris and is also in charge of Wireless OAM & Charging Standards.
