Curriculum vitae for Toon Norp

Toon Norp is Senior Business Consultant mobile networks. Toon has over 20 years' experience in mobile network technology and has an extensive network within the mobile industry. Toon is a regular speaker and panelist at conferences on mobile telecommunications.

Toon Norp joined KPN Research in 1991. At KPN Research, Toon was active in international R&D; as a project member, setting up project proposals, managing work packages, and as an evaluator/reviewer. He was also involved in setting up R&D co-operation between KPN and Telia, Swisscom and Telefonica (within Unisource) and between KPN and NTT DoCoMo. Since 1995, Toon attended mobile network standardisation in ETSI SMG5, SMG3 WPD and later 3GPP SA2.

In 2003, KPN outsourced it's R&D to TNO. Within TNO, Toon has advised KPN, other operators, and governments, on strategy and architecture related to mobile core networks and IMS. Toon continued to represent KPN in 3GPP SA2 standardisation, and since 2007 represents KPN in 3GPP SA1. He has been rapporteur for several 3GPP SA WG1 work items and was chairman of the 3GPP SA WG1 M2M sub-working group from 2008 to 2011. In 2014, Toon was elected as a member of the 5G-PPP, a joint initiative between the European ICT industry and the European Commission to support the research and development of 5G.

Toon holds a Master's Degree in Electrical Engineering from the Eindhoven University of Technology, The Netherlands.
