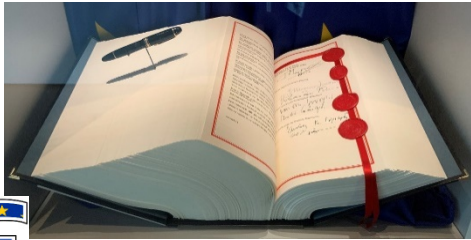




Welcome to Maastricht



- Maastricht is the capital and largest city of Limburg province in the Netherlands that borders Belgium and Germany
 - Meuse-Rhine Euroregion with Aachen (Germany), Liège and Hasselt (Belgium)
- Population: app. 122k.
- History of over 2000 years back to Roman times
 - Traiectum ad Mosam: "ford in the Meuse river"
- Maastricht Treaty agreement
 - Foundation treaty EU
 - Birthplace of EURO as a single European currency.

Public transport NL

Multiple transport companies, e.g.:

- NS (train)
- Arriva (train, bus)

However, all accept OV-Pay (country-wide): you can use your

- **(Foreign) Mastercard or VISA credit cards**
- **(Foreign) Maestro or V-Pay debit cards**

to pay for your journey **without getting a separate ticket**

You just '**check in**' (touch) on entering and '**check out**' (touch again) on exiting; your statement will show the charges

Maastricht - plane



🌐 **Maastricht-Aachen Airport:** is 10 km from MECC Maastricht, from where MECC Maastricht can be reached within 15 minutes by taxi and bus.

🌐 **Eindhoven Airport:**

- Taxi: ~ 1hr 10 min.
- Train: ~ 2hrs. Forum MECC (bs) → Maastricht (bs/ts) → Eindhoven Central station (ts/bs) → [Hermes Bus 401] → Eindhoven Airport

🌐 **Brussels Airport:**

- Taxi: ~ 1hr 20 min.
- Train: ~ 3hr 30 min. Forum MECC (bs) → Maastricht (bs/ts) → 's Hertogenbosch (ts) → Breda (ts) → [by: NS international] → Brussels Airport
- Bus: ~ 2hr 50 min. Forum MECC (bs) → Maastricht (bs) → [by: Flix bus N84] → Leuven (Perron 15) / Leuven (metro) → Brussels Airport

🌐 **Dusseldorf Airport:**

- Taxi: ~ 1 hr 30 min.
- Train: ~3 hrs. Maastricht Randwyck (ts) → Roermond (ts) → Venlo (ts) → Dusseldorf Hbf (ts) → Dusseldorf Flughafen (ts)

🌐 **Amsterdam Schiphol Airport:**

- Taxi: ~ 2 hr 20 min.
- Train: ~ 3 hrs. Forum MECC (bs) → Maastricht (bs/ts) → Eindhoven Central (ts) → Schiphol (ts)



How do I reach the venue, MECC Maastricht?

On average, every five minutes a bus leaves from Maastricht center or Maastricht Central to MECC Maastricht (Forum MECC bus stop).

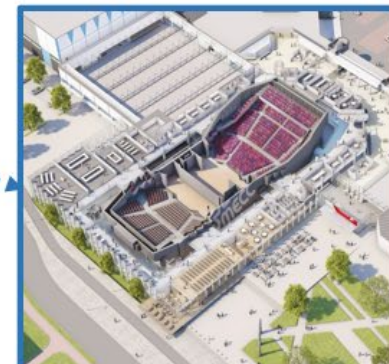

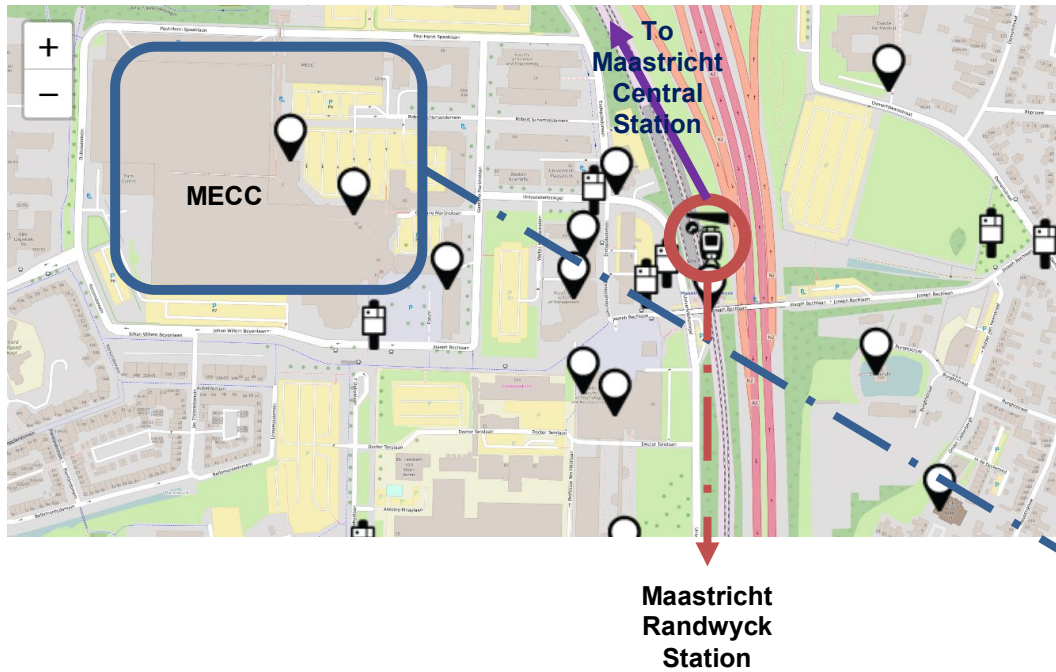

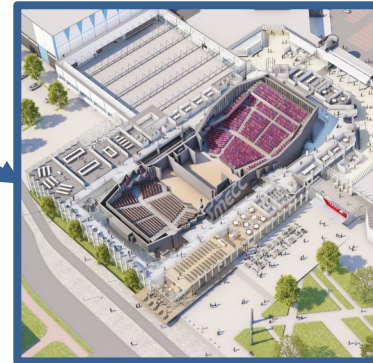


Maastricht - train



Maastricht-Randwyck station is 250 meters away from MECC Maastricht and is connected to an international railway network. In addition, there is a regular connection to **Maastricht Central Station**, which is connected to the (inter)national railway network.

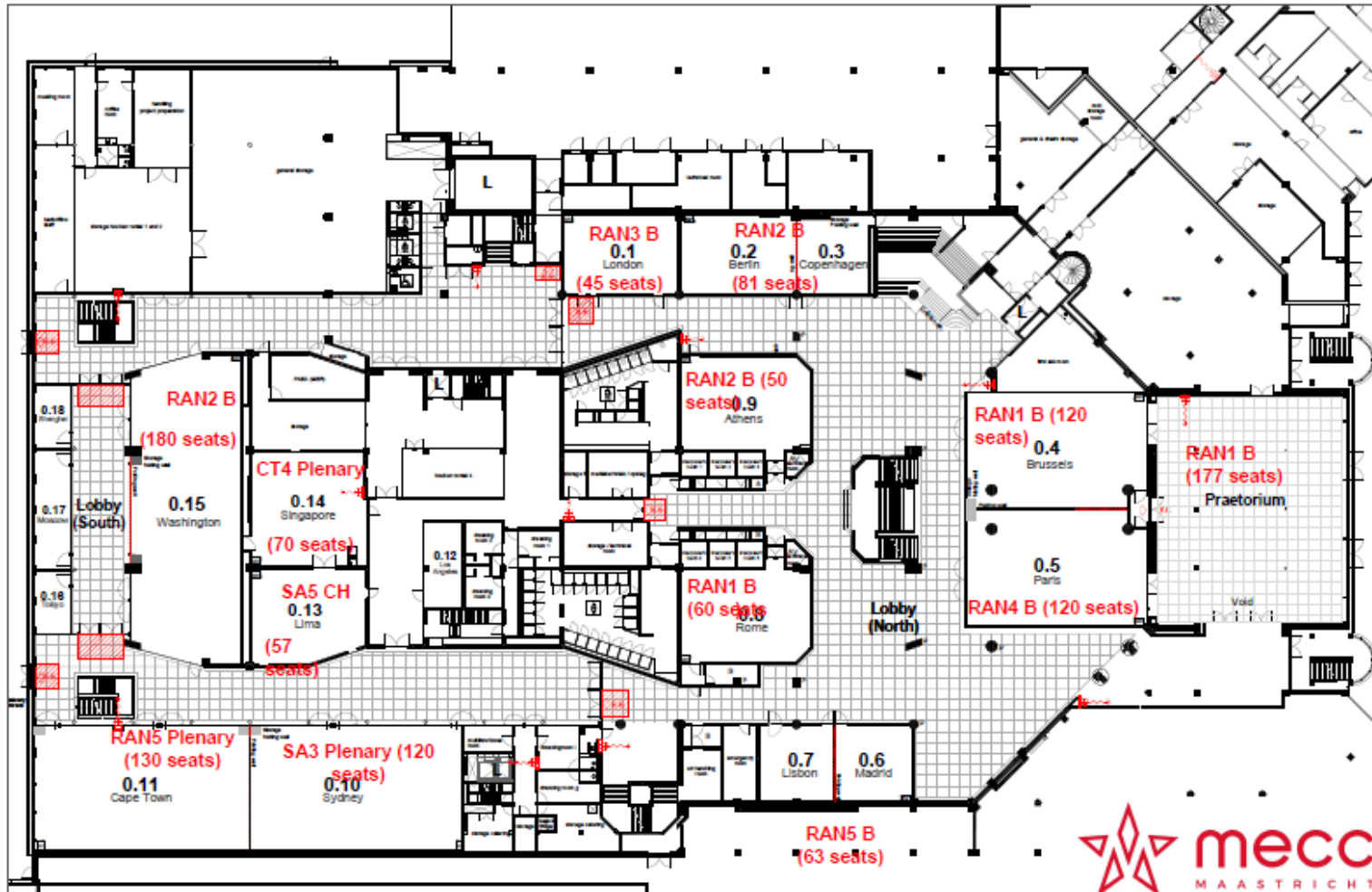

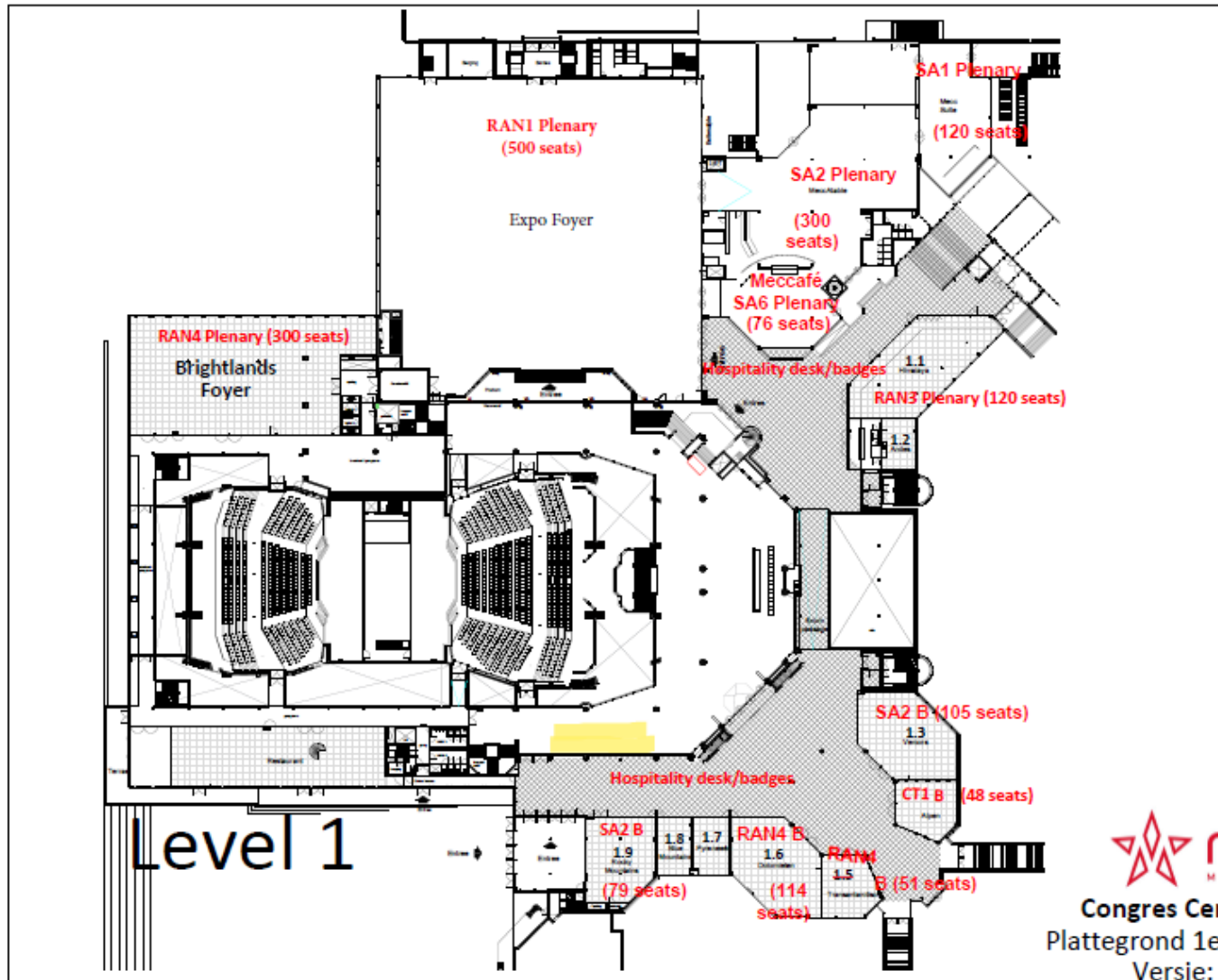

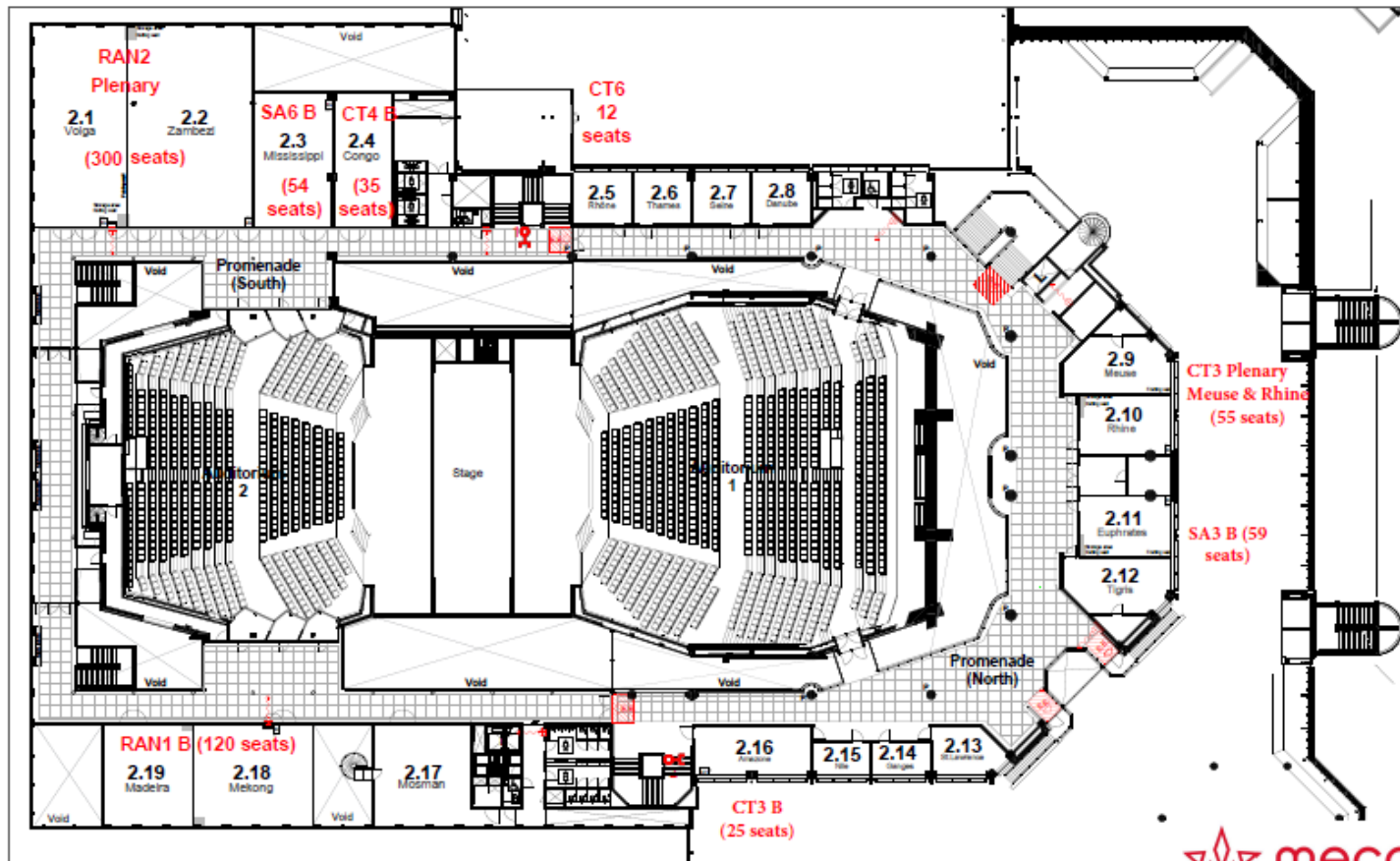

Room plan level 1



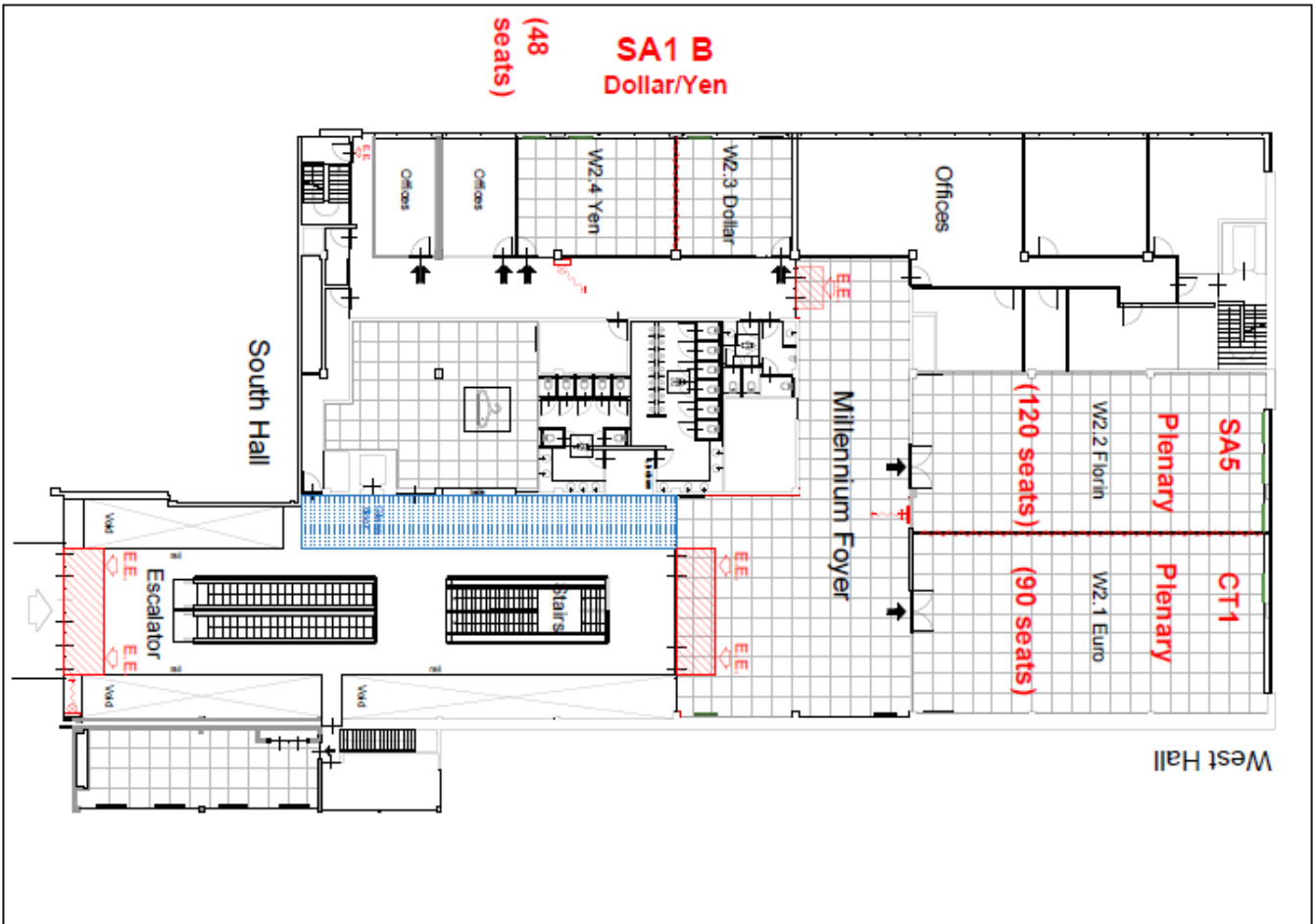
Room plan level 2

When entering the meeting venue, please make sure that you have your QR code available (either on paper or on your mobile phone)

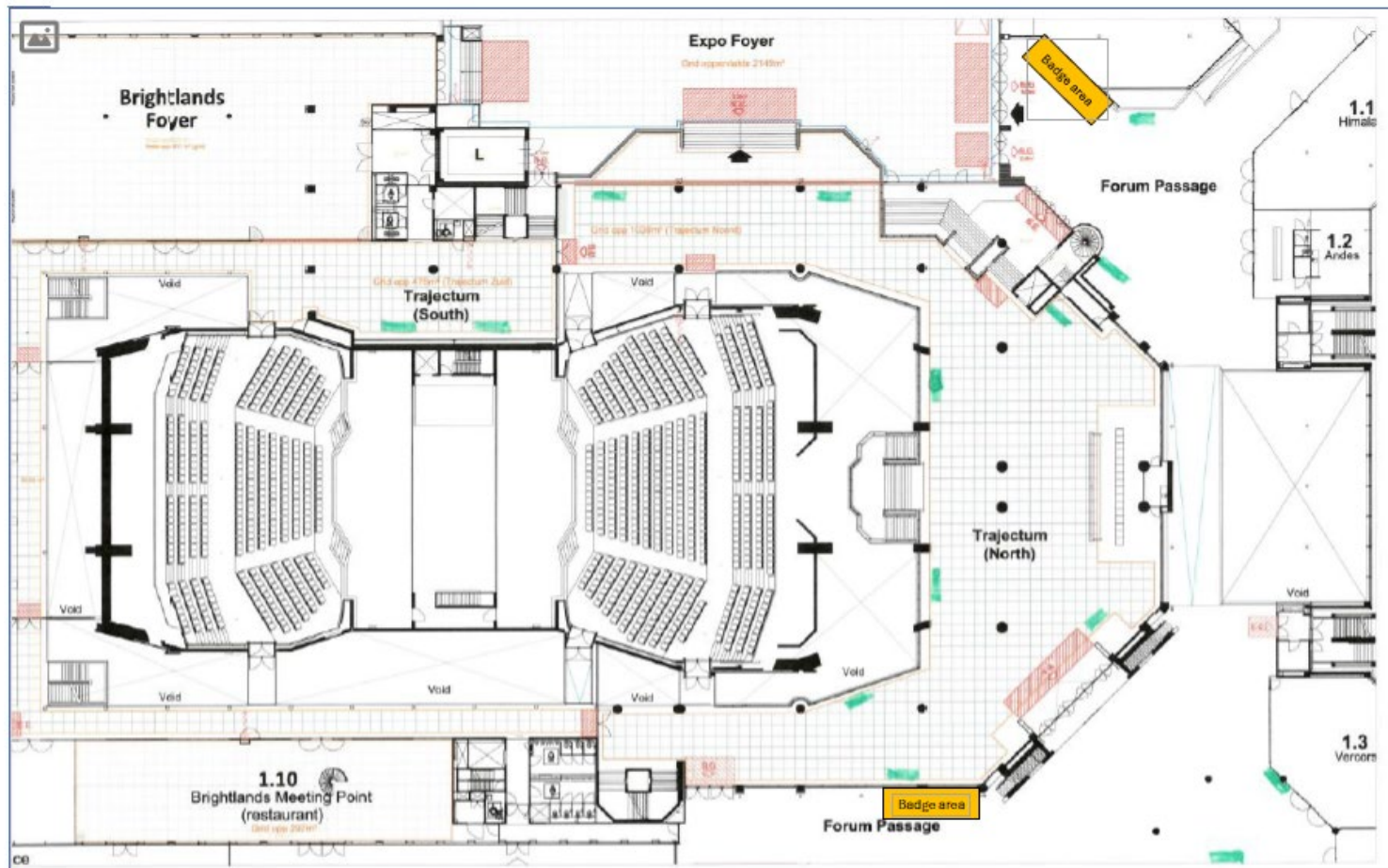

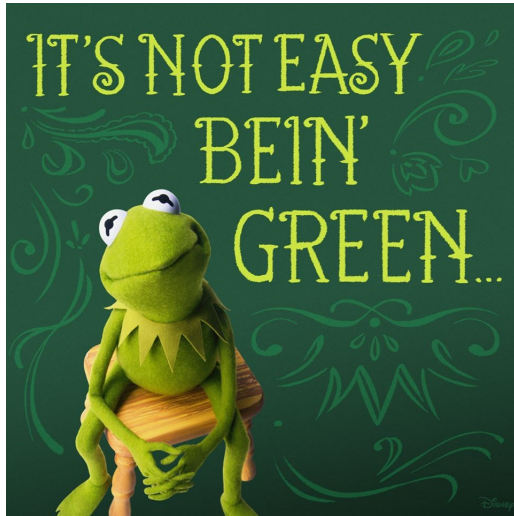

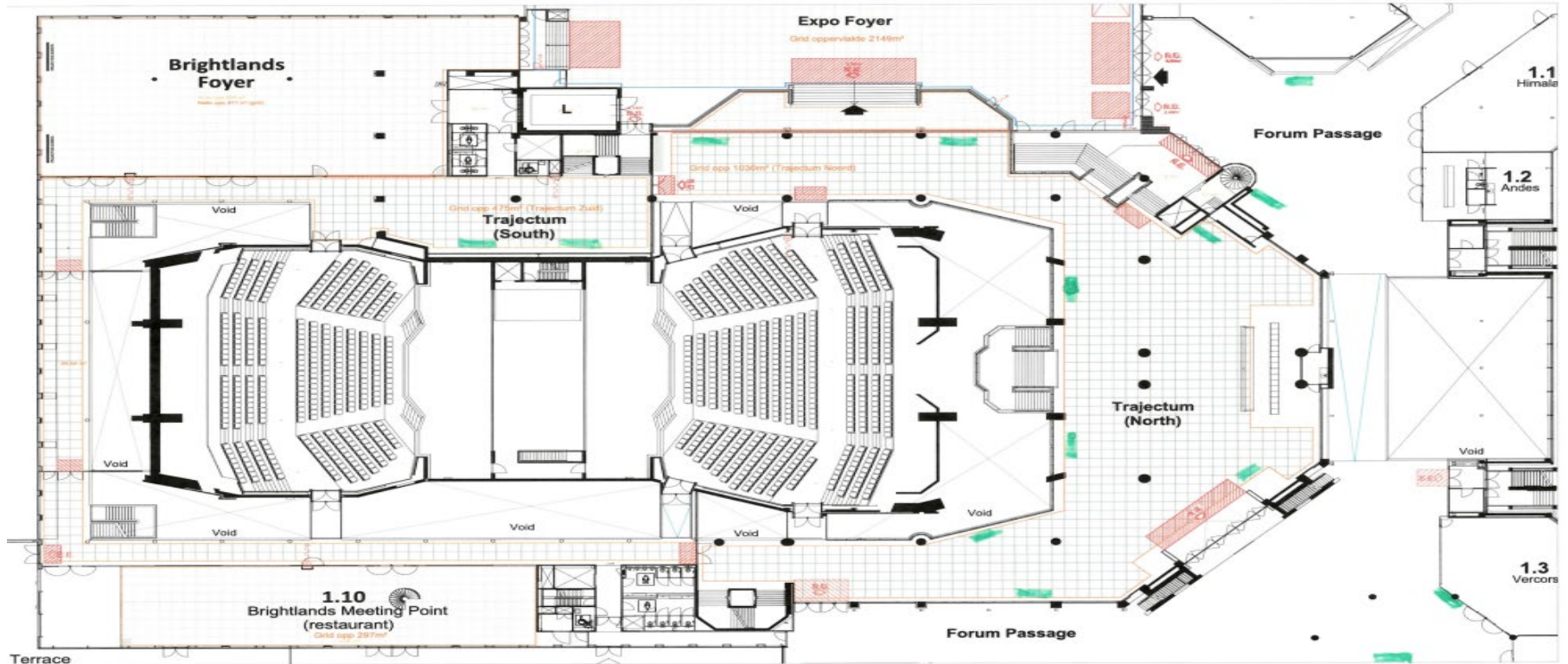


3GPP coffee stations on level 0 - represented in green on the map

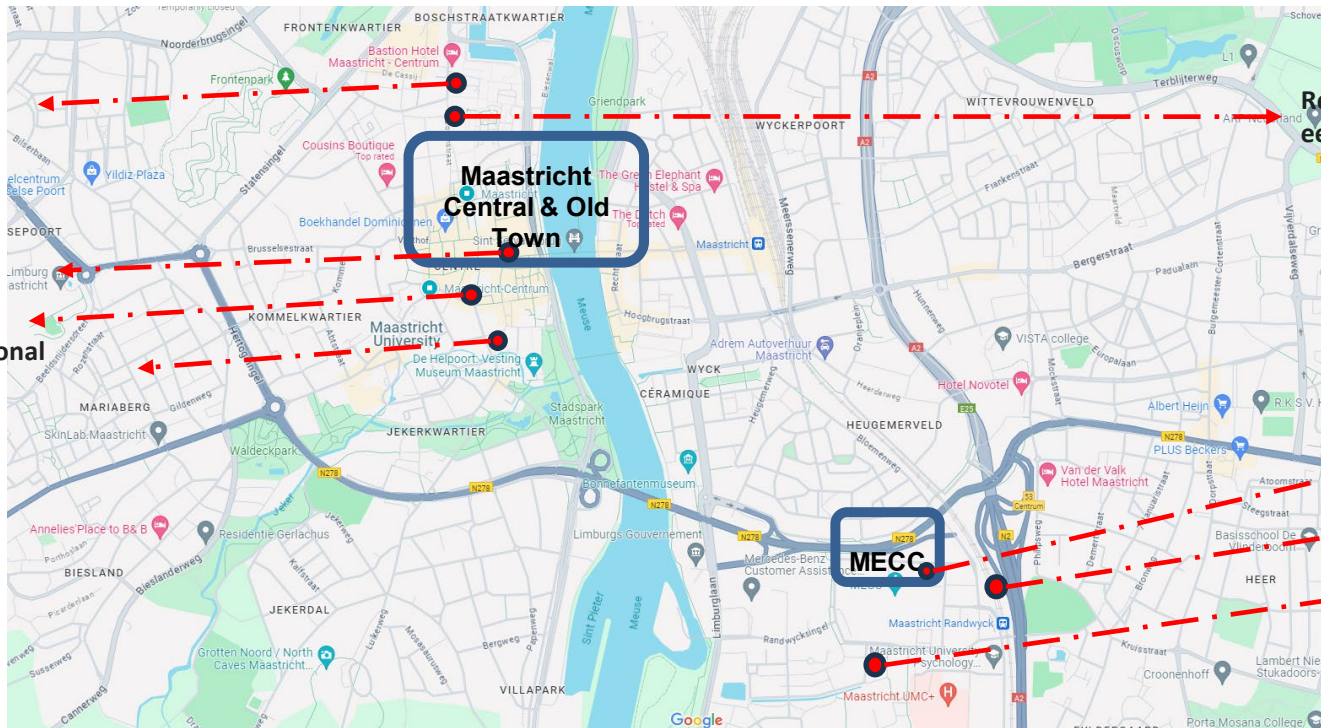

Cuisine

- Indonesian(-inspired) food is a Dutch speciality, found e.g. at Chinese ("Chin.Ind.") restaurants
- Typical Dutch: rijsttafel – "rice table", a shared feast: <https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Rijsttafel>
- A small glossary selection
 - atjar – pickled vegetables; atjar tjampoer (mixed pickles)
 - babi ketjap – pork belly braised in sweet soy sauce
 - babi panggang – roasted pork in a tomato based sauce
 - daging smoor – beef stew
 - gado-gado – vegetables (cooked or fresh) with peanut sauce
 - kroepoek – prawn crackers
 - loempia – spring roll
 - nasi goreng – fried rice
 - nasi rames – "rijsttafel on a plate"
 - pisang goreng – banana fritters
 - rendang – aromatic spicy caramelized beef, braised in coconut milk, chillies, and spices
 - sambal – chilli paste, e.g.: sambal manis (sweet); sambal katjang (peanut sauce); sambal oelek (spicy)
 - saté – various thinly sliced meats, marinated then broiled on a skewer, such as: sate ayam (chicken); sate babi (pork); sate udang (prawn)
 - sajoer lodeh – vegetable stew (spicy) in coconut milk
 - seroendeng – peanuts with sautéed shredded coconut
 - taugé – bean sprouts
 - teloer/ikan boemboe bali – hard-boiled eggs/fish sautéed in Balinese spice mixture
 - tjap tjoy – stir-fried vegetables

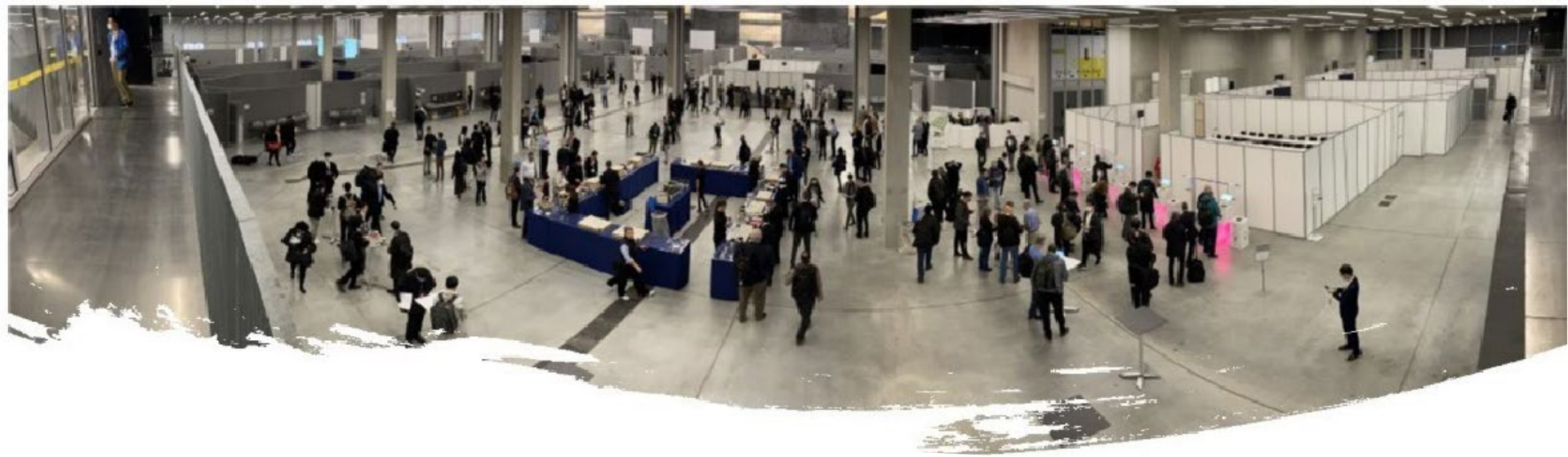
