Valtteri Niemi received his M.Sc degree from the University of Turku, Mathematics Department, in 1987 and Ph. D. degree from the same department in 1989. His Ph. D. thesis "Density of grammatical families" was awarded by the Rolf Nevanlinna institute as the best Finnish mathematics dissertation of the year.

Niemi held several research and teaching positions at University of Turku, including acting as an Associate Professor in Mathematics for the academic year 1992-1993. He was nominated as an Associate Professor in the University of Vaasa, Mathematics and Statistics Department, in 1993 where he stayed until joining Nokia Research Center, Mobile Networks laboratory in 1997. In 1999, Niemi was nominated as a Research Fellow.

Dr. Niemi works in NRC, Helsinki with security issues in future mobile networks and terminals, the main emphasis being on cryptological aspects. He has participated 3GPP TSG SA WG 3 (security) standardization from the beginning. Before that he took part in ETSI SMG 10 work.
