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Open issues in TS33.203

- Overview (Text in Read identifies **outcome from SA3#21bis**):
 - ❖ The content in Section 8 ISIM need to be stabilized (**Open**)
 - ❖ No solution in the main body on how to protect SIP signaling (**Open**)
 - ❖ From SA3#21 it was identified that the extended HTTP Digest draft needs to be enhanced such that it can properly resist replay and reflection attacks (**Approx. Profiling left**)
 - ❖ HTTP Digest will not solve confidentiality of SIP messages. Is this a critical issue in Release 5 time frame? (**Closed**)
 - ❖ IMS UE-split for Release 5? Remove from TS33.203? (**Open**)

Open issues in TS33.203

- Overview:

- ❖ The SA_ID and the handling of SAs should be specified in more detail **(Open)**
- ❖ The requirements on IPsec in relation to encryption of SIP signaling needs to be specified further **(Closed)**
- ❖ What is the IETF view on signaling port numbers in SIP when SAs are switched in the IPsec case? **(Open)**
- ❖ Reduce the number of editors notes **(Open)**
- ❖ Requirements on unprotected re-registrations and SA-handling **(Open)**

IETF-activities (Status reports required for this and future SA3 meetings):

- ❖ 3GPP Requirement IETF drafts related to security
- ❖ Digest AKA
- ❖ Algorithm agreement
- ❖ Extended HTTP Digest

How to proceed to get TS33.203 for approval to SA#15:

Proposed order:

- ❖ Discuss status in **IETF** and agree on **updates to TS33.203** reflecting the status in IETF
- ❖ Agree on working assumption for **SIP signaling protection** i.e. IPsec or Extended HTTP Digest
- ❖ Agree on principles on **unprotected re-registration** and **SA handling**. Accept that details can be sorted out by **CRs** at future meetings.
- ❖ Evaluate the working assumption that a **wrong RES** is not sent to the authenticator
- ❖ Agree on **ISIM** requirements

How to proceed to get TS33.203 for approval to SA#15:

Proposed order:

- ❖ **Drafting session** Tuesday evening (Everyone encouraged to propose items for an agenda)
 - ❖ Review and agree on **TS33.203v110** as in S3-020078 and other contributions or general comments on e.g. Editorial Notes etc.
 - ❖ Refer to IETF drafts or include them in an Annex?
 - ❖ Depending on chosen mechanism but should TS33.203 in order to help CN1 include an Annex for profiling Extended HTTP Digest?
 - ❖ + any other raised issue
