CV of Peter Neumann

Candidate for Vice chair of 3GPP TSG-T

Background

Dr. Peter Neumann joined Siemens in 1991 starting in the Computer Department and moved to Mobile Networks in 1993 dealing with GSM Base Station System, department of system engineering and being responsible for standardization and concepts. At that time he was involved in the completion of the GSM 03.41 Cell Broadcast Service and therefor joined ETSI SMG 4.

In 1995 he moved to Siemens Mobile Phones, mainly dealing with handset applications like AT commands, multiplexing etc. He became an active member of ETSI SMG4 and the main representative from Siemens Mobile Phones starting his contributions at ETSI SMG Plenary#17 as well as in GTAAB and PCN TAEG. He co-ordinated as a Standardization and Regulation Manager all terminal relevant issues including phase 2 Type Approval at SMG Plenary level and was responsible for the co-ordination of Siemens terminal delegates to SMG2, SMG4, SMG7, SMG9 and SMG11.

Since 1997 he became the senior standardization and regulation manager for GSM and UMTS, responsible for all related issues.

He was appointed also to take the lead for standardization of terminal related issues in the 3rd Generation Partnership Project, founded in 1998. He was responsible for the co-ordination of all Mobile Phones delegates in all 3GPP TSG's and himself one of the active delegates in TSG-T and TSG-T2 as well as representing Mobile Phones in the SA-plenary.
