Directions from the Airport:

From Puerto Vallarta Airport:

Exit the airport and proceed south one mile. Turn right at Marina Vallarta Complex. Continue one-half mile to hotel, which is located on left.

The CasaMagna Marriott is only about 2 miles/five minutes from the airport. The hotel does not offer a free shuttle from the airport. A taxi will cost approx. \$6.00 USD **per person** from the airport to the hotel. A taxi from the hotel to the airport will cost a flat rate of approx. \$5.00 USD.

A note on taxi travel in Puerto Vallarta:

Over the last two years the Taxi Syndicate has worked towards having established rates for all areas of Puerto Vallarta. In most cases the driver will give you the correct fare. However, ask before getting in the cab and not at the end of the trip when it's a little more difficult to negotiate. Cash and Credit Cards:

The local currency is the Mexican Peso.

Credit cards are accepted at most places, and they can also be good for obtaining cash withdrawals on your card (for this, you will have to visit a bank and stand in line. Just be sure that you get prior approval before doing so, or you'll be wasting your time.) Ask at one of the desks situated throughout the bank, and they will direct you towards the person who OK's withdrawals. Once you have this approval, you can then stand in the teller's line.

The CasaMagna Marriott accepts credit cards throughout the resort. All charges are quoted in Mexican Pesos. The bank will convert the amount to your local currency when they bill your credit card.
