Background

S8HR roaming VoLTE lawful interception induces regression versus authority expectation.

For a Volte roaming mobile terminating call received by a roamer under lawful interception , it is impossible to provide identity of the caller to authority if the caller is using OIR (Originating Identification Restriction) .

This seems to be a significant difference compared to Circuit Switched mobile terminating to a roamer, where calling identity to lawful interception is provided even if the caller has restricted his identity presentation.

ACTION to 3GPP TSG SA 3-LI

NG NRG kindly asks to 3GPP to investigate possible solution to avoid this limitation if exist.
