1. Introduction

This contribution is to report the status of e-mail discussion on the study item [Iur/4] "Parameter list in Example of signalling flow".

The study item (Iur/4) wrote:

" It should be studied whether the parameters in the Examples on signalling procedures document should be presented in an Annex or with the procedures themselves."

NEC has given a proposal and there was no objection to the NEC proposal.

2. NEC proposal

This study item is related to the document structure and it does not have any technical issue.

NEC proposes to have both in the signalling procedures document i.e. the parameters list should be presented in an Annex and also with the procedures description themselves.

The reason is that people who do not understand English very well will rather like to look at the parameter list in Annex, simply it is easier to understand. For those who have English as a native language, or can understand English very well, can refer to the English text description with the parameters.

3. Conclusion

There is no objection against the above NEC proposal on the e-mail reflector, therefore it is proposed to the editor of the I3.01 to produce an annex to draw up a list of parameters.
