The previous SA1 meeting sent service requirements for push services to the SA2 to guide the evaluation of different solutions to provide push services. These requirements have not been questioned during this SA1 meeting, but SA1 is uncertain on how to proceed with the work.

In the SA1 discussion there were a number of different views on how much of the Push service should be included within the scope of 3GPP. For example, are new functions needed to be defined within 3GPP?

SA1 would like to ask SA2 and T2 for a joint session about the Push service to discuss the main scope of the service and the project plan.
