## **Liaison Statement**

S1 VHE thanks T2 MExE for the liaison statement on the use of user profiles for the support of VHE by MExE.

T2 MExE has correctly identified the use of user profiles to support service personalisation and user interface personalisation.

S1 VHE is in the final stages of completing the Stage 1 requirements for VHE. The Stage 1 specification in 22.21 is responsible for the definition of the service requirements, and it will be the task of VHE Stage 2 to identify the implementation of the service requirements.

The VHE Stage 1 has in fact now made an informative reference to the Composite Capability/Preference Profile being drafted by the World Wide Web Consortium as a possible format for the definition of the user profile. It is of course to be awaited until completion of the VHE Stage 2 for verification of which mechanism will be used for user profiles. S1 VHE notes T2 MExE's merits in W3C's CC/PP, and supports having compatible profiles.
