1. Overall Description:

SA2 is currently working on a number of IMS related work items for release 6 including the stage 2 for the Presence Service. Proposals have been presented in SA2 proposing the use of HTTP within IMS for various service related purposes. It has also been identified within SA2 that there are possible Security and Charging issues currently with the use of HTTP as part of the IMS.

SA2 has not yet identified within release 6 any particular use scenarios for HTTP however it is possible that such scenarios may be identified by SA2 in the future.
