1 **Overall Description**

SA2 thanks SA3 for their liaison on the use of GBA and HTTP for MBMS application layer authentication and authorization. SA2 has considered SA3's questions and responds as follows:

- **Question:** What is the understanding of SA2 regarding the order of application layer joining and bearer level joining procedures ?
 - Answer: SA2's architecture does not place any restrictions on the ordering of application layer procedures (joining or otherwise) and bearer level joining procedures. In fact, SA2's architecture does not specify the nature of the application layer procedures (for example whether there even needs to be a procedure called 'joining') - this is a matter for SA4.
- Question: SA3 would also like to ask SA2 to comment on the relation of application layer joining procedure and bearer level joining procedure
 - SA2's architecture does not require any relationship between application layer Answer: joining (or other) procedures and bearer layer joining procedures.

SA2's understanding is that SA4 has the responsibility for defining the application layer protocols and procedures for the MBMS user services that are to be included in Release 6. This would include, for example, any joining procedures or other aspects such as point to point repair, as well as the actual downlink data stream. SA3 has the responsibility for specifying how these protocols are secured.
