Extended streaming service

SA3 would like to thank the SA4 chairman and the SA1 working group for their recent liaison statements on the extended streaming service (SA4 chairman LS is S3-010174, SA1 LS is S1-010501=S3-010157).

SA3 have noted that the draft work item on extended streaming service is intended to cover transport and content security aspects including the possibility for harmonization of security mechanisms between different multimedia applications. In this respect SA3 would like to point out that there exists a new SA3 work item on end-to-end security which should be applicable to streaming services. The latest version of the end-to-end security work item description is attached for information. It is suggested that both work items cross reference each other in the "linked work items" section of the work item description.

SA3 have also noted that the extended streaming service work item is intending to study rights management. SA3 would be grateful if their expected involvement (if any) with respect to rights management could be clarified.

User profile

SA3 would like to thank SA1 and SA2 for their recent liaison statements on user profiles (S1-010591, S2-011576). The LS proposes that a common description mechanism for user profiles is adopted across all 3GPP specifications. SA3 do not currently believe that there are any security aspects to this work and do not plan to attend the proposed ad-hoc meeting 11-12 June 2001 in Stockholm.
