New ASN.1 Syntax Checking Service

The PEX, as part of the PTCC, constantly seek to improve the services they offer to the ETSI Technical Bodies. For some time it has been noticed that there was a need for the PEX to provide a PEX Helpdesk service of ASN.1 syntax checking, and assistance in the use of ASN.1. The PEX have been looking for a suitable tool in order to provide this service, and have recently found one.

How to use the service

Contact the PEX Helpdesk at the contact points below, or better still e-mail the ASN.1 file to pex@etsi.fr, requesting PEX assistance. Please give information about the context in which the ASN.1 will be used, and also please provide any ASN.1 modules which may be referenced by the module to be checked. Certain commonly used ASN.1 modules, such as TCAP, ROSE and X.500, we already have. This service is also open to 3GPP working groups.

Free ASN.1 Syntax Checking Tool

The tool that the PEX use is also available free on the Web. It is the only tool that the PEX are aware of which provides syntax checking for both ASN.1:1990 (X.208) and ASN.1:1997 (X.680). Note that ITU-T SG.7 will soon withdraw X.208. It is recommended that editors use the tool to remove basic ASN.1 syntax errors before contacting the PEX for more detailed assistance.
