Curriculum Vitae of Lewis Milton Candidate for Vice-Chairman of 3GPP TSG CT WG4

Mr. Milton received a Bachelor of Science degree in Physics in 1963 and Master of Science degree in Physics in 1965, both from the University of Illinois at Urbana, Illinois. He also received a Master of Business Administration from the University of Chicago in 1978.

After working in the applied nuclear research industry from 1966 until 1980, Lew worked in landline switching software development at AT&T Bell Labs from 1980 to 1990. He has worked in cellular telephony at Motorola for almost 20 years, and has an extensive background in cellular standards, beginning with CDMA standards development in the Telecommunications Standards Institute (TIA) and 3GPP2 from 1995 to 2008.

Mr. Milton was Vice Chair of the TIA TR45.2 Core Network Standards Subcommittee for two years and then Chair for two more years. At the same time he was also the Vice Chair and then Chair of 3GPP2 TSG-X Core Network Standards WG4-Project Management for a total of more than 3 years.
