Brief Curriculum Vitae of Stéphane Ragot

Mr. Stéphane Ragot received the *Diplôme d'Ingénieur* (M.Sc.) in Telecommunication Engineering from Telecom Bretagne, France, in 1997 and M.A.Sc. and Ph.D. degrees in Electrical Engineering from the University of Sherbrooke, Canada, in 2000 and 2003. He was a Research Assistant/*Coopérant* at Univ. Sherbrooke in 1997-2003 and a Research Engineer with VoiceAge Corporation in 2000-2003. He joined Orange Labs (formerly France Telecom R&D), Lannion, France in 2003, and he now holds a position of Senior Research Engineer in Signal Processing/Coding and Expert in Communication Services in Orange. Stéphane has authored about 40 scientific publications.

He has been involved in the development of 3GPP AMR-WB+ when working with VoiceAge and he then contributed to the development of several ITU-T codecs (G.729.1, G.722 App. IV, G.711.1, G.718, G.729.1E, G.722B) in Orange. He was an ITU-T SG16 delegate for France Telecom/Orange in 2004-2008.

Since Jan. 2008, Stéphane has been representing Orange in 3GPP SA4 and coordinating the Orange delegation in this working group. In 3GPP SA4 he has been (co-)Rapporteur for several work items on terminal acoustics (Rel-8, Rel-11, Rel-12, Rel-13) and he has been involved in the EVS codec standardisation since its beginning (acting as EVS SWG Secretary and EVS-3 Editor). He organized several 3GPP SA4 ad-hoc SWG meetings.
